

# High and Extreme Severity Events: March 30, 2026 Conflict Between US, Israel, Gulf Countries and Iran

## Israel

- Multiple waves of Color Red sirens were sounded across Israel throughout March 30, 2026.
- Affected northern areas included Metulla, Kfar Giladi, Kfar Yuval, Margalioth, Misgav Am, Tel Hai, Ma'ayan Baruch, Kiryat Shmona, Beit Hillel, Dafna, HaGoshrim, Kibutz Dan, Shear Yeshuv, Sdeh Nechemia, Kfar Blum, Amir, Dovev, Iftach, Malkia, Ramot Naftali, and Manara.
- Rocket/missile and hostile aircraft sirens were sounded in multiple northern areas at 06:02.
- Hostile aircraft intrusion sirens were sounded in northern Israel's Zarit, Ya'ara, Arab al-Aramshe, Shomera, Even Menachem, and Shtula at 04:07.
- Sirens were sounded in multiple northern areas including Haifa and Kiryat Yam at 04:01 local time.
- The Israel Defense Forces neutralized two militant incidents in the West Bank during overnight hours on March 29-30, 2026.
- In the Dura area, the Israel Defense Forces identified an armed militant with a knife charging towards emergency personnel.

## United Arab Emirates

- Multiple explosions were heard across Dubai City during early morning hours on March 30, 2026.
- Authorities confirmed the explosions were due to successful air defense interception operations.
- Air defense systems were actively engaged in countering incoming threats.

## Saudi Arabia

- The Ministry of Defense confirmed the successful interception and destruction of five ballistic missiles launched towards the Eastern region during early morning hours on March 30, 2026.
- The missiles were completely destroyed before reaching their targets.
- Information on damages or casualties remains unknown at the time of writing.

## Bahrain

- The Ministry of Interior confirmed air raid sirens were sounded nationwide during early morning hours on March 30, 2026.
- Citizens and residents were urged to remain calm and proceed to the nearest safe place.

- The sirens indicated potential Iranian missile and Unmanned Aerial Vehicle threats.

## Regional Assessment

- March 30, 2026 marked a significant escalation in the conflict between Iran and the US-Israel-Gulf coalition.
- Iran launched coordinated attacks targeting multiple countries simultaneously.
- Five ballistic missiles were directed at Saudi Arabia's Eastern region.
- Multiple missiles and UAVs targeted the United Arab Emirates, specifically Dubai.
- Bahrain faced nationwide threats requiring air raid sirens.
- The attacks demonstrated Iran's capability to conduct multi-front operations.
- Air defense systems across the Gulf countries and Israel were actively engaged throughout the early morning hours.
- The simultaneous nature of the attacks suggests coordinated planning and execution.
- The targeting of civilian areas in Israel, including major cities like Haifa and Be'er Sheva, represents a significant escalation.
- The attacks on Gulf countries, particularly the UAE and Saudi Arabia, indicate Iran's willingness to expand the conflict beyond Israel.
- The successful interception of multiple threats demonstrates the effectiveness of regional air defense cooperation.
- The conflict shows no signs of de-escalation as of March 30, 2026.
