

High and Extreme Severity Events - March 19, 2026

Iran-US-Israel-Gulf Conflict

ISRAEL

- Color Red sirens sounded in multiple areas of central Israel including Tel Aviv at 23:31 on March 18, 2026.
- The Israel Defense Forces attributed the sirens to missile launches from Iran.
- Four people were killed following a missile attack in Beit Awa during late night hours on March 18, 2026.
- Shrapnel fall was reported in Lachish.
- Vehicles caught fire in Holon following missile impacts during early morning hours on March 18, 2026.
- A warehouse caught fire in Michmar HaShiv'a.
- Magen David Adom confirmed emergency operations were ongoing in affected areas.
- No injuries were reported in Holon as of writing.

ISRAEL DEFENSE FORCES OPERATIONS IN IRAN

- The Israel Defense Forces confirmed strikes on sites in northern Iran during overnight hours of March 18-19, 2026.
- This marked the first time since the war began that Israeli air forces targeted northern Iran. • Iranian naval vessels in the Caspian Sea near Bandar Anzali, Gilan Province were targeted.
- Buildings of customs, ports, and maritime authorities were struck.
- The Tamjidi shipyard area was targeted.
- The Hassan Roud naval base was targeted.

UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

- Missiles targeting Habshan gas facilities and the Bab field in Habshan, Abu Dhabi were intercepted during overnight hours on March 18-19, 2026.
- Two incidents of shrapnel falling resulted from successful interceptions.
- Operations at the gas facilities were suspended.
- No injuries were reported as of writing.
- Air defense systems remained active due to missile and Unmanned Aerial Vehicle threats during late night hours on March 18, 2026.
- The Ministry of Defense confirmed explosions were the result of air defense interceptions.

SAUDI ARABIA

- The General Directorate of Saudi Civil Defense issued a warning in the Eastern Province during overnight hours on March 18-19, 2026.
- The Ministry of Defense confirmed two Unmanned Aerial Vehicles and one ballistic missile were intercepted and neutralized in the eastern region.
- Six Unmanned Aerial Vehicles were intercepted targeting a gas plant and energy facilities in Eastern Province during late night hours on March 18, 2026.
- Four residents were injured in Riyadh due to shrapnel falling post-interception of a ballistic missile.
- Limited material damage was recorded over a residential site in Riyadh.
- Four ballistic missiles were intercepted in Riyadh during night hours on March 18, 2026.
- Debris fell in various parts of Riyadh.

QATAR

- Explosions were recorded following a missile attack on Ras Laffan Industrial City during night hours on March 18, 2026.
- QatarEnergy confirmed fires caused extensive damage.
- Emergency response teams were deployed to contain the fires.
- All personnel were accounted for with no casualties reported as of writing.

IRAQ

- A fire was reported following an attack on Kirkuk Air Base, Kirkuk Governorate on March 18, 2026.
- The Iraqi Ministry of Defense stated a "war projectile" targeted the base.
- Technical teams contained the fire preventing its spread. • No casualties were reported.
- An Unmanned Aerial Vehicle attack was reported near Baghdad International Airport during night hours on March 18, 2026.
- Preliminary reports indicated the attack targeted a US logistics support camp near the airport.
