Status Update

The ongoing war with Iran has severely disrupted regional transit, leading to operational disruptions across regional transportation hubs due to ongoing airstrikes and excessive traffic.

Land borders throughout the Middle East remain operational. Several crossings in the region are experiencing heightened security measures and intermittent processing delays, which have impacted transit times.

Air travel across the region remains significantly disrupted amid the ongoing conflict. Airspace in Kuwait and Iraq remains closed. However, Bahrain has amended its airspace closure. While it is still closed for all flights, an exception has been made for departures from Bahrain International Airport (BAH) following a specific route, with prior permission. One business jet departure has been noted from BAH, as of writing. Airspace in Qatar, the UAE, and Israel remains severely restricted. Saudi Arabia, Egypt, and Oman maintain open airspace; however, delays and flight cancellations have been reported.

Maritime routes across the Middle East remain accessible but operate within a highly constrained security environment as the regional threat level remains **extreme**. Bahrain's Khalifa Bin Salman Port is set to resume operations today, which were suspended on March 12-13 due to the ongoing conflict in the region and resultant maritime disruptions.

Logistically, essential services across most Gulf states remain stable despite the ongoing regional escalation. However, the closure and militarization of the Strait of Hormuz are significantly disrupting global energy flows. The waterway normally carries around one-fifth of global oil and LNG shipments, but tanker traffic through the corridor has sharply declined due to security risks. At the same time, LNG exports from Qatar and the UAE have been suspended, removing a substantial share of global supply from the market. Early effects are already visible, with fuel shortages reported in parts of Africa and South Asia, and if the disruption persists, secondary supply constraints are likely to begin affecting additional markets across the Middle East and Central Asia in the coming weeks as reserves tighten and alternative shipping routes remain limited.
