

# High and Extreme Severity Events: April 07, 2026

## US-Israel-Gulf-Iran Conflict

### Israel

#### Central Israel - Morning Missile Barrage

- Damage reported in multiple areas of central Israel, including Tel Aviv, following Iranian missile launches during late morning hours on April 07, 2026.
- Submunition from fragmentation missile fell near residential building in Tel Aviv.
- Six impact sites recorded in Gush Dan area.
- Additional impacts and shrapnel reported across Sharon region.
- Magen David Adom confirmed crash sites in Ramat Gan and Rosh HaAyin.
- Sirens sounded in multiple central and southern areas including Tel Aviv at 09:07 on April 07, 2026.

#### Northern Israel - Sustained Rocket Fire

- Sirens activated in multiple northern areas including Bi'ina, Deir al-Asad, Karmiel, and Lavon at 10:31 on April 07, 2026.

### Saudi Arabia & Bahrain

- King Fahd Causeway temporarily suspended to all vehicle traffic during morning hours on April 07, 2026.
- General Authority for King Fahd Causeway confirmed suspension as precautionary measure.
- Closure prompted by alerts from National Early Warning Platform in Eastern Region.
- Suspension represented response to escalating regional security situation.
- Critical transportation link between Saudi Arabia and Bahrain completely closed.

### Bahrain

- Ministry of Interior confirmed sirens sounded nationwide during early morning hours on April 07, 2026.
- Alert indicated incoming Iranian aerial threats requiring immediate shelter procedures.

### United Arab Emirates

- Ministry of Interior confirmed air defenses active due to missile threats nationwide during early morning hours on April 07, 2026.
- Defense systems responding to potential Iranian missiles and Unmanned Aerial Vehicle threats.
- US and Israeli-linked sites identified as potential targets.

### Strategic Assessment

#### Iranian Offensive Operations

- Major Iranian missile barrage targeted central Israel during morning hours on April 07, 2026.
- Attack represented significant escalation with widespread damage across Tel Aviv metropolitan area.
- Fragmentation missiles deployed against civilian infrastructure.
- Coordinated timing with Gulf region alerts indicated multi-front Iranian operation.

#### Regional Infrastructure Impact

- King Fahd Causeway closure represented unprecedented disruption to Gulf transportation.
- Suspension affected critical economic and civilian movement between Saudi Arabia and Bahrain.
- Closure duration remained unconfirmed as of April 07, 2026.

#### Risk Environment

- Extreme risk level maintained across Israel, UAE, Bahrain, and Saudi Arabia.
- Air defense systems operating continuously across multiple countries.
- Critical infrastructure targeted for closure as precautionary measure.
- Regional conflict showing sustained intensity on April 07, 2026.
- Iranian offensive operations maintaining pressure across multiple fronts simultaneously.
